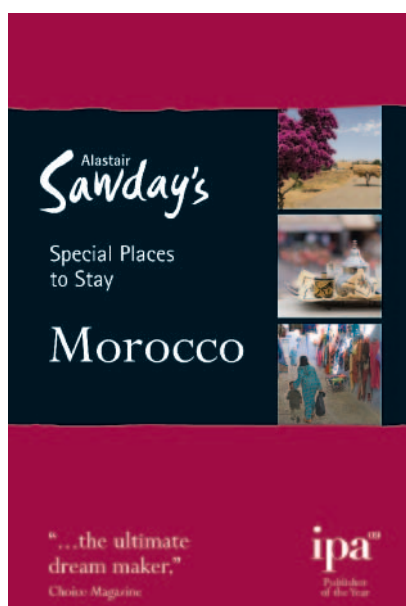

- Find The Good Life, Morocco style in a mountain-walkers B&B Berber lodge; chickens and vegetables straight from the garden become delicious tagines; fires burn brightly and the High Atlas mountains beckon... bring your boots
- Stargaze at an astronomical kasbah hotel in the desert; there's an observatory on the roof terrace and guided constellation spotting till midnight. Come sunrise camels and 4x4s are available with desert guides.

Below North Africa's highest peak the valley soars away to fertile terraces and red villages. This feudal stronghold is a Berber-European union born of the desire to share its splendours with like-minded visitors. Many rooms are positively luxurious, while the salons with their cushioned sleeping benches are aimed at groups. Get fascinating glimpses of the culture on the walks and mule treks (lasting one hour to one week), then relax in the huge hammam. Dining is romantically hushed; cuisine is local not haute, and alcohol-free. The Kasbah supports the local community in education and health; 5% is added to your bill to help fund projects. *Day trips to Marrakech.*
